



Wound healing has three distinct phases: inflammation, proliferation and tissue remodeling.9 Many factors can stall this three-phase healing process, causing dramatic delays in wound healing. Medline provides advanced and biologically derived therapies to help alter the physiological deficiencies that underlie

chronic or delayed wounds.

Hyalomatrix with HYAFF®, completely esterified hyaluronic acid (HA), is the next generation of care for slow-healing wounds. Upon contact with the wound bed, the HYAFF transforms into a hydrophilic gel and integrates with the surrounding tissue. This biodegradable matrix acts as a 3-D scaffold for cellular invasion—facilitating the colonization of fibroblasts and vascular cellsas well as capillary growth. 11 The HYAFF fibers provide HA to the wound bed in a prolonged manner, encouraging epidermal cell migration. This leads to new dermal tissue reconstruction. along with spontaneous re-epithelialization. 11, 12




